#### Covid Vaccine Clinic



UMH provides care to patients who meet criteria under our charity care policy without charge or at discounted rates. A half-cent sales tax revenue is distributed to Uvalde County and designated for healthcare expenditures. Fifty-five percent of this half-cent is allocated to UMH and this year covers just 5.6% of the hospital's annual charity care.
